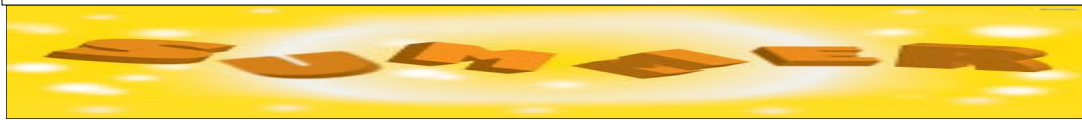

Learning Through Play

Play is a very important way in which children learn. It helps to build self worth by giving a child a sense of his or her own abilities and to feel good about themselves. Because play is fun, children often become very absorbed in what they are doing. In turn, this helps them develop the ability to concentrate. Providing children with a range of play things will help them learn in a number of ways.

Ways in which to grow a child's creativity and imagination is to allow a child to paint, draw, play with dough. You can let the child play dress up or house. Children love to imitate what they see and it allows them to write their own story.

You can give a child building blocks, jigsaw puzzles or shape sorters which helps the recognize shapes, sizes. It also helps them learn to put things in order and develop logic without even knowing.

When you let a child play outside running, jumping, climbing or even ball games they are working on flexibility, strength and co-ordination.

Children learn by using all of the senses: taste, touch, seeing, hearing and smelling.
